

Safety Tips for Litter Cleanup at ZAP50

1. What to Wear:

- Wear bright colored clothing. A bright t-shirt will help others see you when on the roads
 or use a safety vest if you have one.
- Wear closed-toed shoes.
- Long pants and long sleeves are recommended for wooded cleanups or where vegetation is high.
- Wear gloves and use a litter picker if available.
- Watch for poison ivy and bugs, and do a tick check when you are finished. Use a lint roller over your clothes before you take them off.

2. Do's and Don'ts:

- Do not pick up anything dangerous, heavy, broken, etc. Leave it and/or report it.
- Do not open any bottles to empty liquids.
- Do not touch any needles. Report their location.

3. During the cleanup:

- When on the roads, walk against traffic so that YOU can see the cars traveling on the road
- Never rub ground or litter with your gloves. Glass/sharp objects can puncture gloves.
- Do not touch your face.
- Watch where you step.
- When cleaning near brush and bushes, watch your eyes. Glasses offer extra protection.

4. Post Cleanup:

- Tightly secure the litter bag when full. Add your gloves if finished for the day.
- Use disinfectant wipe on your hands, if available.
- Consolidate litter as much as possible if getting picked up.
- Notify those needed to remove the collected litter if applicable.
